## WHERETHE JOBS ARED

The median annual wage for healthcare practitioners and technical occupations is higher than the median annual wage for all occupations in the economy. Employment in healthcare occupations is projected to grow much faster than the average for all occupations, adding about 2.4 million new jobs.
